A motion that the aforesaid contract be executed was passed and approved by unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Councilman Sam Greenwell, seconded by Councilman Jones, that an ordinance, a copy of which is hereto attached, entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MORGANFIELD, KENTUCKY, ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR NATURAL GAS SERVICE TO BE RENDERED BY THE NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OF SAID CITY, EFFECTIVE WHEN SAID SYSTEM HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND IS PLACED IN OPERATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORGANFIELD, KENTUCKY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Rates and charges for natural gas services for municipal, domestic, commercial, and industrial purposes are hereby established, to become effective when the municipally owned natural gas distribution system has been completed and placed in operation, and such rates and charges shall be applicable equally and without discrimination both to customers who may be inside and customers who may be outside the corporate limits of said City, as follows:

Residential and Small Commercial

First	500 cu. ft. or less per month.....	\$1.25 (Min bill)
Next	2500 cu. ft. per month.....	1.25 per MCF
Next	7000 cu. ft. per month.....	1.10 per MCF
Next	10,000 cu. ft. per month.....	.90 per MCF
Over	20,000 cu. ft. per month.....	.80 per MCF

Large Commercial and Specials

First	500 cu. ft. or less per month.....	\$1.50 (Min bill)
Next	500 cu. ft. per month.....	1.25 per MCF
Next	7000 cu. ft. per month.....	1.00 per MCF
Next	30,000 cu. ft. per month.....	.80 per MCF
Over	40,000 cu. ft. per month.....	.65 per MCF

Section 2. Premises receiving natural gas service shall be individually metered, and each dwelling unit in a duplex, apartment house or other multi-unit establishment shall be deemed to be a separate unit and shall have a separate meter.

Section 3. Bills for natural gas service in accordance with the foregoing schedule shall be mailed to each customer as nearly as may be on the First day of each calendar month, and the face amount of each bill shall be due and payable until the tenth day after the mailing of the bill. After ten days from the date of mailing, a penalty of ten per cent (10%) shall be added to the face amount of each bill, and interest shall accrue at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum until such bill is paid. If any bill shall remain unpaid at the end of thirty (30) days from the date of billing, the gas service to the premises shall be disconnected, and no reconnection of the same customer shall be permitted, except upon payment of the bill, penalty, and interest, together with a disconnection charge of \$2.50 and a reconnection charge of \$2.50.

Section 4. For each connection made to the municipally owned natural gas distribution system, the customer shall pay in advance a connection charge of \$10.00 and for each meter installed, the customer, if not a property owner of the property where the meter is installed, shall make a meter deposit in the amount of \$7.50 out of which shall be paid damages, if any, to said meter and any unpaid natural gas bills at any time determined by the City Council of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall go into effect upon adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication as contemplated by law, and shall be effective as soon as natural gas service is provided through the facilities of the municipally owned natural gas distribution system of said City now authorized and about to be constructed.

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ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky, at a meeting held on May 4, 1956 on the same occasion signed by the Mayor as evidence of his approval, ordered to be published, and declared to be effective upon publication as provided by law.
