

ORDINANCE NO. 1/1933

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND DEFINING THE KIND AND TYPE OF PIPE AND PIPE FITTINGS TO BE USED IN THE INSTALLATION AND/OR RELAYING SERVICE WATER LINE PIPES FROM THE WATER MAIN TO THE WATER METERS AND IN AND UNDER THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF MORGANFIELD, KENTUCKY, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

The City Council of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky do ordain as follows:- That on and after the passage and publication of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful to install or re-lay service water pipe lines and fittings therefor in and/or under the streets and/or alleys within the City limits of the City of Morganfield, except as follows:

FIRST: All service water lines as contemplated in this ordinance shall be of pure copper and such copper water lines shall be of not less than three-quarter of an inch in diameter and the gauges of such piping shall be as follows and not otherwise; For three-quarter inch piping, sixteen guage-BWG; for one and one-half inch piping, fifteen guage-BWG AND FOR TWO INCH Piping, fourteen guage-BWG.

SECOND: Fittings used for such installations as contemplated by this ordinance shall be those known as standard copper pipe fittings.

THIRD: If other than the piping and fittings contemplated by this ordinance shall be used in any original installation or other installations as provided herein, the City shall have the right to dismantle and remove such installations and the materials so used other than those provided for in this ordinance and discontinue water service to the property owner or owners permitting such illegal materials to be used in the original or other installations of such water service lines.

FOURTH: Any person violating any section of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor, shall be fined not to exceed the sum of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars and any such fines as may be imposed there under are hereby appropriated to the General Fund of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky.

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
