

At a called meeting of the City Council held April 21, 1936, there being present Mayor Waller Young and Councilmen Offutt, Inge, Alhorn, Fenwick and Truitt.

A motion was made by Councilman Alhorn seconded by Councilman Fenwick that the following ordinance be voted upon by the Council:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Morganfield that the following described lands be and they are now included within the city limits of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a point on the East side of the Morganfield-Boxville road 30 feet from center at the end of Richards Street; thence with the east side of said street; N 47 E 800 feet to a telephone post; thence S 35 #E1480 feet to a ditch; thence up said ditch S 63 W 865 feet to the Morganfield-Boxville road; thence with the East side of said road N 36 W 515 feet; thence N 29 3/4 W 728 feet to the beginning and containing 26 acres of land.

The vote was as follows: Offutt, Yes; Inge, Yes; Alhorn, Yes; Fenwick, Yes; Truitt, Yes.

There being no further business the Council adjourned subject to meet on the regular meeting night, Friday, May 1, 1936.
