

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX A PORTION OF CAMP BRECKINRIDGE TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF MORGANFIELD, KENTUCKY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 81.219 and 81.220 OF THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES.

The City Council of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Morganfield, Kentucky desires to and hereby proposes to annex the following defined territory to the City of Morganfield, Kentucky:

DESCRIPTION:

Beginning at the City Limits of Morganfield, Kentucky at the Highway right-of-way line on the South-west side of Ky. 56 at Fannie Brown's North property line which is the East City Limits of Morganfield, Kentucky; thence with the South-West right-of-way line of Ky. 56 in an Easterly direction approximately 12,000 feet to a point near Little Union on Ky. 56 which is 200 feet on the South East Side of Camp Breckinridge Road E, the foregoing line, from the point where the White Oak Spring Farm and the Camp Breckinridge Reservation boundary meet, shall run on a parallel line 200 feet South of the South-West side of Ky 56 from that point to Little Union so that the property 200 feet South of the South right-of-way of Ky. 56 from the Military Reservation boundary to Little Union shall be included in this annexation; thence on a parallel line 200 feet on the South-East side of Camp Breckinridge Road E North-East approximately 5200 feet to a point 200 feet on the South-West side of Camp Breckinridge West road; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with Camp Breckinridge Road W South-East 400 feet to a point 200 feet on the South-East side of Camp Breckinridge Road F; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with Camp Breckinridge Road F North-East 400 feet to a point 200 feet on the South-West side of Range Road A; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with Range Road A South-East 2110 feet to a point 200 feet on the South-East side of the Kit Harris Road; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with the Kit Harris Road North-East approximately 2,000 feet to a point 200 feet on the South-West side of the Ben Harris Road; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with the Ben Harris Road South-East approximately 2,800 feet to the east bank of Little Union Creek; thence North-East down the East bank of the Little Union Creek approximately 4,000 feet to the East bank of Casey Creek; thence North-East down the east bank of Casey Creek; approximately 7,800 feet to a point North-East of the old McClure Chapel Road Bridge; thence on a line North approximately 8,500 feet to a point 200 feet on the North-East side of Roberts Lane; thence on a parallel line 200 feet with Roberts Lane North-West approximately 5,600 feet to a point on the North-West side of the right-of-way line of Ky. US 60; thence with the North-West right-of-way line of Ky. US 60 South-West approximately 19,600 feet to the City Limits of Morganfield, Kentucky, opposite the Dairy Maid Drive Inn; thence with the City Limits across Ky. US 60, 90 feet to the South-East right of way of Ky. US 60; thence with the South-East right of way of Ky US 60 North-East approximately 7,920 feet to the Camp

Breckinridge Military Reservation boundary; thence along the Camp Breckinridge Military Reservation boundary, also Waller Young's property line, South-West approximately 5,600 feet along the Camp Breckinridge Military Reservation Boundary to a point at the North-East right-of-way line of the Beaver Dam Road and the Camp Breckinridge Military Reservation Boundary; thence with the North-East right-of-way line of the Beaver Dam Road North-West approximately 3,325 feet to the City Limits of Morganfield, Kentucky, opposite the old CCC Camp; thence with the City Limits South-West approximately 40 feet to the South-West right-of-way line of the Beaver Dam Road; thence with the south-west right-of-way line of the Beaver Dam Road South-East approximately 3,325 feet to the Camp Breckinridge Military Reservation Boundary; thence south-west approximately 4,000 feet along the Camp Breckinridge Military Reservation Boundary, also Aaron Bickett's property line, to a point on the north-east side of Ky. 56; thence with Ky. 56 North-West right-of-way line approximately 3,000 feet to the City Limits of Morganfield, Kentucky, at the City Park; thence South-West with the City Limits to the South-West side of Ky. 56, the point of the beginning and containing approximately 6,213 acres, more or less. A map of the foregoing annexed property is attached hereto.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published for not less than three (3) weeks in the Union County Advocate at Morganfield, Kentucky.

Section 3. Within thirty (30) days after the adoption, publication and advertisement of this Ordinance, a petition shall be filed in the Circuit Clerk's Office of Union County, Kentucky wherein the City of Morganfield is situated, in the name and on behalf of the City, setting forth the passage, publication, advertisement of the Ordinance and its object and purposes, together with an accurate description by metes and bounds of the said territory proposed to be annexed, and praying for a Judgment to annex said described territory to the City of Morganfield, Kentucky.

Section 4. Notice of the filing of the said petition in the Union Circuit Court Clerk's Office shall be given in the same manner as notice of the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
