

~~AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I OF THE ORDINANCE ADOPTED MARCH 16, 1956, LEVYING A LICENSE TAX ON MOTOR DRIVEN VEHICLES.~~

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Morganfield, as follows:

SECTION I (a) That for the purpose of raising revenue for the proper maintenance of the City Government of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky, there be and there is hereby levied an annual license tax of \$5.00 upon each and every motor driven vehicle driven or used upon the streets and the public highways of the City of Morganfield, Kentucky, and owned by any person, firm, or corporation resident in the City of Morganfield, Kentucky.

SECTION I (b) Should purchaser of said license sell or trade the vehicle licensed within the licensed period the City Clerk may issue the seller a new permit for fee of 50 cents for each different car owned, and the buyer of the licensed car may continue to use permit attached to car purchased. If not, he or she will purchase new vehicle license as required by this ordinance. In no event shall owner of any one vehicle in the City of Morganfield pay in excess of \$5.00 for annual permit, except for the cost of new permit (a fee of 50 cents) when changing ownership of a vehicle.
